

Dear Parents,

The Edmonton Police Service along with your child's principal and teacher, are committed to maintaining traffic safety and order around your school.

Enforcing bylaws and traffic safety laws around school zones is **vital**. These laws have been created to keep you and your child safe.

The Edmonton Police Service would like to kindly remind parents and other motorists of some important bylaws and traffic safety laws that contribute to the overall safety of the roads near your child's school:



U-Turns are dangerous and pose a high risk for collisions, particularly when traffic is busy. U-Turns are also illegal unless otherwise indicated.

In most cases, a U-Turn ticket will cost you **\$115.00** or more, and add an upwards of **2 demerits** to your license.



Jaywalking is dangerous for pedestrians and can result in a pedestrian getting hit by a vehicle and rear-end collisions. For everyone's safety, use the marked crosswalk even if it is not the most direct route to your vehicle.

Under a City of Edmonton Bylaw, you can be fined **\$250.00** for jaywalking.



Parking Violations are troublesome and can cause severe traffic congestion. Congestion, in turn, can lead to impatience among motorists that can result in collisions or injuries.

Most parking violations will cost you **\$50.00** and some can result in your car being towed.
