The awards include the Rose Margaret King Merit Awards, the Don Howden & Jane Squire Howden Awards and the Teri Taylor-Tunski Awards. These awards support students who are in financial need and have attended school in Edmonton at some point between kindergarten and Grade 12. All three awards can be applied to through a single application form.

Priority is given to students who have attended an inner city school; exhibit a commitment to their studies; and who can show that they have selected a program that will lead to improved employment opportunities.
