Important Year-End Schedule Information

As we approach final exams, several schedule adjustments will be in place over the next two weeks. On June 2 and 3, students in English and Social Studies 10 and 20 will write their Part A provincial assessments, resulting in a revised class schedule for DOUBLE BLOCK DAYS:

June 2nd, 2026: Students attend block 1 all morning and block 3 all afternoon. *Please do not send your students to school if they have a block 1 spare or block 3 spare in the afternoon.

June 3rd, 2026: Students attend block 2 all morning and block 4 all afternoon. *Please do not send your students to school if they have a block 2 spare or block 4 spare in the afternoon.

June 10 and 11, 2026: Tutorial Days and PART A DIPLOMAS in ENGLISH AND SOCIAL

To support students preparing for final exams and diploma assessments. English and Social Studies 30 students writing Part A Diploma Exams will attend their scheduled exams, while all other students are encouraged to register for tutorial sessions through PowerSchool to complete coursework, assessments, or exam preparation.

Please note that lockers must be emptied by June 9. From June 12 to June 23, regular classes will not be in session, and students will attend school only for their scheduled final exams
