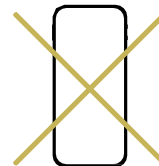

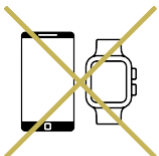

**No personal electronic devices, with the exception
approved calculators, are allowed in the exam room
(even if they are turned off).**



- Examples of electronic devices that are **not allowed** include cell phones and wearable technology like an Apple Watch etc.
- Approved calculators must be cleared by a supervisor before and after the diploma exam.



FINALS & DIPLOMA EXAMS INFORMATION



STUDENT IDENTIFICATION

- All students **MUST** have picture identification with them when they arrive to write any examination.
- Any of the following identification documents is acceptable: driver's license, passport, or student identification card.
- An unknown student who cannot produce appropriate picture ID will not be allowed to write the diploma examination.



LATE ARRIVALS

- Students who arrive **more than one hour after** a diploma examination has started will **NOT** be allowed to write the examination.
- Students who arrive late but within the first hour of administration may be allowed to write.



ADMITTANCE TO EXAM ROOM

- Students **may not enter** or **leave** the examination room without the consent of the supervising examiner.



IDENTIFICATION ON EXAM

- Students **must not** write their names or the name of their school anywhere in or on an examination booklet, except in the designated space provided or if required



MATERIALS IN THE EXAM ROOM

- Any student in possession of materials not allowed in an examination room will have his/her mark invalidated.
- Students may not remove any examinations or other examination materials from the examination room.

Who: Grads who have paid their Grad fees may pick up their grad gown, stole, cap and date charm, along with their wristbands for entry into each event, their complimentary grad photo and their commemorative graduation certificate.

*All gowns and stoles are individually packaged for each student according to size. These gowns, caps, and stoles are for you to keep and are included in the grad fee. It would be advisable to hang the gown, and even steam or iron it prior to the commencement ceremony.

- Hard copy tickets will be issued to grads on Thursday, June 5th at school and will be in the form of wristbands. A seating chart will be provided at the entrance to the Hall. **NO REFUNDS OR CHANGES CAN BE MADE ONCE TICKETS HAVE BEEN PURCHASED AND TABLES HAVE BEEN SELECTED.**
- Please note, that in accordance with Edmonton Catholic School District procedure, the Graduation Dinner will be alcohol free. As a result the ECC will not be serving alcohol during the evening's event and students will not be admitted entry if they appear visibly intoxicated
