Excellence Awards	
Award	Criteria
Jeanette McMillan Perseverance Award NEW PLAQUE-THEA	<p>This award goes to a student who has demonstrated strength and courage in the face of adversity and who thereby serves as a model for the school community. This student leads with passion and confidence always.</p> <p>Deadline to apply: June 30th <i>(internal application)</i></p>
Newcomer Award THEA	<p>This award goes to a student who has moved to Canada within the last five years and who shows commitment to pursue excellence. They have also been involved in school life and shown academic success.</p> <p>Deadline to apply: June 30th <i>(internal application)</i></p>

Mill Woods Lions Club	<p>This award (typically) goes to a grade 12 student who has contributed significantly to service in the community. This could include areas such as Red Cross Volunteer, Hospital Volunteer, Millwoods Community Programs, etc.</p> <p>Deadline to apply: June 30th</p>
Knights of Columbus Spirit Award	<p>This award is given to a student who has completed High School (in the current year), and is accepted into a post-secondary program for the upcoming year. They must have at least a B average to apply, and outstanding attendance (no more than 3 classes missed in total without a valid reason). The student must also be involved in at least one school <u>AND</u> one church extra-curricular activity <u>OR</u> community/volunteer service.</p> <p>Deadline to apply: June 30th</p>

Spirit of Trinity Award Silver Medal	This award goes to a <u>grade 11 student</u> who has made significant contributions in the school in terms of leadership, service and community involvement. silver medal	
Spirit of Trinity Award Gold Medal	This award goes to a <u>grade 12 student</u> who has made significant contributions in the school in terms of leadership, service and community involvement.	

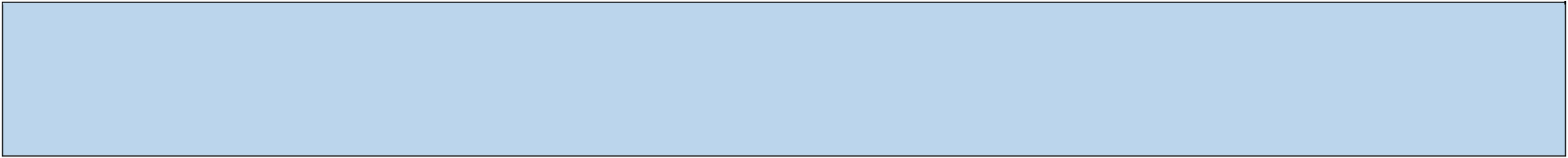
HIGHEST MARK AWARDS/HONORS

Honors Award: A student who achieves Honors status in terms of their grades should feel a great sense of accomplishment. They have maintained an average mark of 80% and higher, with no mark under 65% in all of their classes. • A list of student names will be posted and students can request a paper copy of the award (for 2024-2025 recipients)

Honors with Distinction: Student has maintained an average mark of 90% and higher, with no mark below 65% in all of their classes. *A List of student names will be posted. Student awards will be distributed when the student RSVPs to the awards celebration (for 2024-2025)

Humanities Award (English & Social)	This award goes to a student who has the highest average in both English 30-1 and Social 30-1. NO APPLICATION
Math & Sciences Award	This award goes to the student with the highest average in two of Biology 30, Chemistry 30, Physics 30 and Science 30 and one of Math 30 or 31. NO APPLICATION

Knowledge & Employability / General Studies Top Award	This award goes to the student with the highest average in all K & E courses. NO APPLICATION

Students must; demonstrate Christian Action, have completed a minimum of 50 service hours in one school year, be involved in the Catholic Church, display Catholic values, have a B average (or better), be selfless in their service action and always work with a positive attitude.</p> <p>Deadline: June 30th</p> <p>gold medal (per winner), name engraved on plaque</p>

Highest Academic Average – Grade 10	<p>This award goes to a student who has the highest-grade 10 average in <u>all courses</u>.</p> <p>NO APPLICATION</p>
Highest Academic Average – Grade 11	<p>This award goes to a student who has the highest-grade 11 average in <u>all courses</u>.</p> <p>NO APPLICATION</p>
Highest Academic Average – Grade 12	NO APPLICATION
Governor General's Medallion	<p>This award goes to a student who achieves the highest average upon graduation from a secondary school. This average includes all grade 11 and grade 12 courses (regardless of stream or subjects, all students are eligible upon graduation).</p> <p>NO APPLICATION</p> <p>medal supplied by Federal Government Office of Governor General certificate</p>
